<sup>37</sup> No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

and mind. And love your neighbor as yourself.

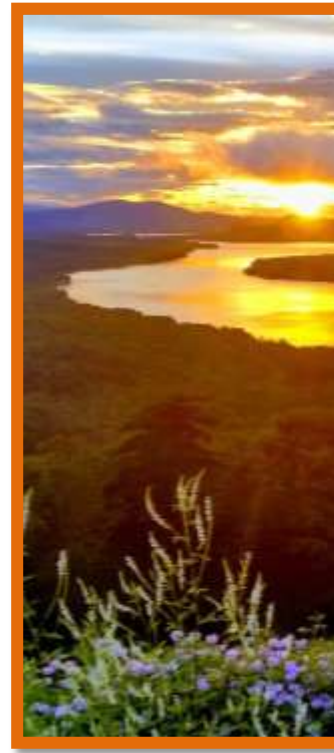
